Ending Direct Deposit

If you want to stop direct deposit to your bank account, fill out this form and mail or fax it to our office.

Why would I want to stop direct deposit?

You may stop direct deposit if you close or transfer your bank account, or if you choose to receive your child support payments on the Kids Card.

What happens when I stop direct deposit?

As soon as this form is received at our office, we will stop all deposits to your bank account. Your child support payments will then go on a Kids Card, which will be mailed to you within 5 - 7 days.

What if I don't want a Kids Card?

If you want your direct deposit to go to a different bank or account, you will need to fill out a new direct deposit application. This application is available on our website, or by calling our office.
